- Adopt micro-grid technology and Modular Nuclear Reactors
- Build multiple new gas-fueled power plants
- Explore state-of-the-art hydrogen technology
- Expand energy generation through food waste

HOUSING

200,000 affordable To build housing units over the next five years, the Builders Agenda will:

- **8** Eliminate many of the archaic barriers to development
- Unlock the reserves from local Affordable Housing Trust Funds, providing more options
- Allow for denser development
- Create Housing Incentive **Zones**, leveraging state or municipal funds to prioritize development in these areas
